12 operating budget and the projects listed in the capital budget from the amounts estimated to be

21       (a) The City reasonably expects to reimburse the expenditures described in Subsection (b) of  
 22 this Section with the proceeds of one or more obligations (as such term is used in Treas. Reg.  
 23 Section 1.150-1(b) to be incurred by the City (or any entity controlled by the City within the  
 24 meaning of Treas. Reg. Section 1.150-1). The City intends that this Section of this Ordinance of  
 25 Estimates (as this Ordinance of Estimates may be amended from time to time) shall serve as a  
 26 declaration of the City's reasonable intention to reimburse expenditures as required by Treas.  
 27 Reg. Section 1.150-2 and any successor regulation.

28       (b) The City intends that this declaration will cover all reimbursement of expenditures for  
 29 capital projects or programs approved in the capital budget contained in this Ordinance of  
 30 Estimates to the extent that the City has appropriated in this Ordinance of Estimates to pay the  
 31 cost thereof from one or more obligations to be issued by the City (or any entity controlled by  
 32 the City within the meaning of Treas. Reg. Section 1.150-1). The term "obligation" (as such  
 33 term is defined in Treas. Reg. Section 1.150(b) and as used in this Section) includes general  
 34 obligation bonds and notes, revenue bonds and notes, leases, conditional purchase agreements  
 35 and other obligations of the City (or any entity controlled by the City within the meaning of  
 36 Treas. Reg. Section 1.150-1).

37       (c) The maximum anticipated debt expected to be incurred by the City to reimburse the cost  
 38 of each capital project or program in this Ordinance of Estimates is the applicable appropriation  
 39 listed in this Ordinance of Estimates from the proceeds of one or more obligations, as such  
 40 appropriations may be increased or decreased.




